This training will allow participants to become engaged in the system responses to intimate partner violence among individuals who identify as LGBTQ. This is not your average panel presentation! We will move through various scenarios that will aid training participants in learning important information that may assist LGBTQ survivors of intimate partner violence. Representatives from BSO Law Enforcement, BSO Fire Rescue, Broward Health, Broward County Sexual Assault Treatment Center, Broward County Clerk of Courts Domestic Violence and Pro Se Division and Women In Distress will engage training participants and provide vital information directly from those who are most likely to be the first responders to a scene, or to be the first to interact with a survivor who may be reaching out for help.

The first portion of the training will include a discussion of the dynamics of intimate partner violence among those who identify as LGBTQ and will specifically focus on the tactics that abusers may use which exploit sexual orientation and gender identity and expression in order to gain and maintain power and control over their intimate partner.
